What is a Pastoral Sabbatical?

The concept of a pastoral sabbatical comes from the pattern we see in Scripture for Rest and Renewal. In Genesis 1, the Lord set the example for us by ceasing from His work on the seventh day of creation. He then made Sabbath rest a regular requirement for His people, commanding them to observe the Sabbath Day (one day out of every seven; see Ex 20:8-11) and the Sabbath Year (one year out of every seven; see Lev 25:1-5). We have structured our sabbatical policy to reflect this Biblical principle.

The sabbatical is not a time of extended vacation. The pastor is accountable to the Board of Elders for how he uses this time. The Board approves a sabbatical proposal before the sabbatical begins, and the pastor reports back to the Elders when it is completed.

We believe the time provided during a sabbatical will allow our pastors to pursue a plan of personal and professional renewal and growth. This in turn will enhance their service to the Lord and to our church. In addition, we believe the pastor's time away will provide opportunities for others within our body to express their gifts and assist in meeting the ministry needs of our church.

Pastoral Sabbatical Summer 2022

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do other churches offer sabbaticals?

A growing number of Bible-believing churches are appreciating the value of granting their pastors sabbatical time. Both the Evangelical Free Church of America and the Central District of the EFCA recommend that EFCA churches implement a sabbatical policy for their pastoral staff.

Why this summer?

Our sabbatical policy provides for up to three months of sabbatical time after every six years of service to our church, with the sabbatical to be taken at some point during the seventh year. Pastor Don has served as our Senior Pastor since 2008. His last sabbatical was in the summer of 2015.

How long will this sabbatical be?

Pastor Don's sabbatical will run from May 23, 2022 through August 28, 2022. This stretch of time includes 2 weeks of regular vacation time.

So what will Pastor Don actually be doing during the sabbatical?

Don and the Elders have identified three primary goals for this sabbatical:

- Writing Project: Don's main goal for this sabbatical is to write a draft manuscript of a devotional book based on 1 John.
- Renew, Refresh, and Recharge: They say you can't draw water from a dry well, and the principle applies spiritually too. Don will be using this time to replenish his own "spiritual well" for the next season of ministry.
- Ministry Projects: Don also hopes to work on a couple of big picture projects for our church that have been difficult to get to in the regular course of ministry.

Who will preach this summer?

We are planning a team approach to the pulpit ministry. Pastor Andrew will be taking 5-6 Sundays to preach through Jonah. Other weeks will be covered by guest speakers, some of our Global Partners, and several of our own Elders and other men from our church.

Who will cover Pastor Don's other responsibilities while he is on sabbatical?

The Elders, Pastor Andrew, and the ministry staff will cover Don's pastoral and administrative responsibilities as needed during these three months. If the need should arise for a funeral, we will work with the family and funeral home to ensure a pastor is available.

Who should I contact if I have a crisis and need pastoral care?

Please feel free to call on any of our Elders or Pastor Andrew. GracePoint is an Elder-led church, and we encourage you to call on any of these men if you want prayer or spiritual counsel.

Will our church be in a "holding pattern" during this time?

Not at all! We are grateful for the leadership of our pastors. But we believe that the Body of Christ does the work of the ministry (Eph 4:11-12). Our summer ministry season will look much the same as it usually does, and we will enter the fall with a recharged Senior Pastor.
