New GracePoint Children's Church Option

This spring, we are offering Children's Church for an expanded age group as a trial. Over the years, we have offered Children's Church for preschool students through Grade 2 only.

Beginning today, we want to try out an expanded Children's Church program for children through Grade 5.

The Details:

- Children are dismissed for Children's Church near the end of the musical worship time. Usually there is a note on the song slides saying Lil' Praisers are dismissed. Parents can accompany their children to the class, or you are welcome to send them on their own if they already know the way.
- When Children's Church is offered for the rest of the spring, children who attend Children's Church will have two options: a preschool (ages 3-4) through Grade 1 group that will meet in the upstairs children's classroom (down the hallway past the restrooms) and a group for Grades 2-5 that will meet in the downstairs Blue Room.
- The current rotation of Children's Church teachers will be teaching the preschool-Grade 1 class, and will be using the Bible in Life curriculum from David C. Cook.
- Christina Bateman will be teaching the Grade 2-5 class and will be using The Gospel Project's .Jesus the Messiah curriculum.
- Nursery care continues to be available in the Nursery Room for the entire service for infants through children up to age 3.
- Children's Church will <u>not</u> be offered on Easter Sunday (April 17) or Memorial Day weekend (May 29). In addition, the Summit conference in May will have its own special student programming, and so our regular Children's Church and Sunday School classes will not meet on those Sundays (May 8 and May 15).

As with all of our children's programming at GracePoint, it is completely up to parents and caregivers to decide what best serves your discipleship goals for your children. Families are welcome to have their children stay in the worship service for the sermon time if they prefer.
