Wednesday Night Meal Ministry

We have started our Wednesday Night Meals back up for the Awana year! It's time to refresh you about the opportunities that are available to help and serve.

First of all, we are looking to provide all or most of each meal through donations of food from the Church body. You can sign up for for just an item or 2, or however many you would like to. There is a list for each meal broken down for you to sign up for.

Next, we have a number of different volunteer roles that help make the meal happen each week. Here are short "job descriptions" for each role:

- 1. Set-up/servers: set up tables and chairs, and wash tables; then help with serving the meal, if needed. Arrive at 5 p.m.
- Tuesday Prep Volunteer: Talk with Meal Team Leader, and brown the required amount of hamburger, bag and place in frig. Cook spaghetti noodles and bag, on this week. Clean fruit and veggies. Do anytime on Tuesday.
- Meal team leader: Pull meat or food out of freezer, if needed. Speak with Tuesday Prep Volunteer to coordinate. Follow the meal recipe and directions and lead the team in meal prep. Date/label all freezer leftovers. Arrive at 4:00-4:30 p.m.
- 4. Cooks and Servers: Help Team Leader prepare meal, help serve the meal, and clean up if no clean up crew. Arrive at 5-5:30 p.m.
- Clean up Crew: Help take down tables and chairs and vacuum fellowship hall. Wash dishes and assist with getting food put away and labeled. Take out trash. Clean up kitchen. Arrive at 6:00 p.m.
